Agenda Items:

- Approve meeting minutes from October 8, 2020
- Goal: Develop recommendations for a nutrient management approach in the Falmouth portion of the Highland Lake Watershed, consisting of the Highland Lake Residential District (800-foot deep strip of land abutting the lake shore) and the Highland Lake Conservation Overlay District (Falmouth portion of the watershed)
- Criteria to consider when formulating recommendations:
  - Animal type (hobby farm animals)
  - Animal density (animals per acre)
  - Terrain (e.g., slope of land)
  - Proximity to water bodies and wetlands
  - Natural buffers
  - Structural BMPs
  - Imported feed versus grazing
  - Rotational grazing
  - Manure management/containment
  - Summer management versus winter management
  - Drinking water sources
  - Location and type of shelters
  - Other criteria
- Identify resources for research – federal, state, and local agencies
  - Federal example - USDA
  - State example - Maine Department of Agriculture, Conservation, and Forestry
  - Local example – Windham
- Assign areas of research to committee members
- Schedule and set date and time for next meeting
